

Sunday, August 21 – Quarry Road Track, Hornsby Valley

This hilly walk follows a fire trail that leads down into the Hornsby Valley. We will see the Steele Military Bridge which was installed in 1964-65 to provide access to fire-fighting vehicles from Hornsby to Dural. We will walk part of the Great North Walk along the Berowra Creek and return via Fish Ponds to Manor Road, Hornsby. Access from the track to Manor Road is via a 2 metre ladder.

Meet: End of Stewart Ave, Hornsby. (Gregory's Map 77 C2 or Sydway Greater Sydney Map 194 M19). Meet @ 9.45.

Length : 4-5km **Estimated duration :** 3 hours approx **Difficulty :** Moderate/Difficult, steep ascent/descent. Final ascent is via 2 metre ladder

At the end of the walk you may join us for STEP provided refreshments at Manor Road. It is then approx 10 minute walk to return to the cars in Stewart Ave
